

The sustainability focus comes from the ship's design. The bow features a significant curve that helps the boat cut through waves, reducing drag. Ultimately, this helps Theory decrease fossil-fuel intake by 30 percent. There are also special wastewater systems utilized on the boat to make the most of the resources onboard.
